The Clinical Trials Pharmacist is part of the Pharmacy Clinical Trial service. The role works closely with the Clinical Trial Pharmacy technician, Wellington Blood and Cancer Centre Clinical Trials Unit and CCDHB Research Office, along with the associated wider team to support the Clinical Trial service and ensure appropriate use of resources for same.

The Clinical Trials Pharmacist oversees the Clinical Trial Pharmacy service across Capital & Coast and works closely with the Clinical Trials Technician.

- Regularly updates and reviews all batch sheets and protocols, to ensure their validity and relevance with regards to Clinical Trials.
- Ensures that all documentation for the trial has been double-checked, all data is accurate and correct, and signed off.
- Supports the Clinical Trials Technician and if required provides cover in their absence.
- Integrated into the multidisciplinary team within area of responsibility.
- Answers complex clinical questions from prescribers, liaising with colleagues if outside area of experience.
- Understands the importance of Good Clinical Practice (GCP) when undertaking clinical trial related activities.
- Leads clinical practice through alignment with recognised best practice and relevant clinical policies and practice guidelines.
- Assists and supports team members in the preparation and supply of investigational products in line with procedures to maintain quality & minimise risk.
- Ensures correct investigational product storage.
- Validates labels, dispenses and accurately self-checks clinical trial prescriptions ensuring legislative requirements are met and local protocols followed.
- Participates in the provision of inpatient services dispensary, medicines information, aseptic and cytotoxic production and dispensing, subject to appropriate training.
- Provides a clinical pharmacy service to a key clinical area, under direction of the Clinical Team Leader.
- Raises concerns to pharmacy production team leader (or delegated person) regarding Clinical Trials related medication safety matters/risks. Raises concerns to pharmacy clinical leader (or delegated person) regarding other medication safety matters/risks (i.e. clinical decision making of senior healthcare professionals).
- Provides detailed knowledge, advice and recommendations for pharmacy staff and other healthcare professionals to support identifying and resolving complex medication related problems to optimise medicines use.
- Provides advice, teaching and instructions to patients, carers and relatives to positively influence medication related behaviours.
- Answers complex clinical questions from prescribers, liaising with colleagues if outside area of experience.
